OVERVIEW OF SITE ACTIVITY

Upcoming Activities

- The ground for the parking lot and main access are being leveled to prepare for asphalt.
- Campus perimeter retaining walls are being erected over the next several weeks.
- Completion of the metal roofing is targeted for the beginning of June.
- PEPCO and other utilities will work to install upgraded service to the new building during June and July.

Working Hours

- Approved work hours are 7 A.M. to 7 P.M. Mondays through Saturdays (except Holidays).
- Construction vehicles will be parking on the construction site. Trucks will not be allowed to idle, and muddy wheels on construction vehicles will be washed before entering public roads.
